<b>alarmed</b> I was alarmed by the loud bang.	<b>alarming</b> What an alarming noise!
<b>amused</b> He was amused to hear his little son singing in the bath.	<b>amusing</b> That TV programme is really amusing.
<b>bored</b> The students looked bored as the teacher talked and talked.	<b>boring</b> I've never seen such a boring film!
<b>confused</b> I was confused, because I asked two people and they told me two different things.	<b>confusing</b> I find these instructions very confusing! Could you come and help me?
<b>depressed</b> I was feeling depressed, so I stayed at home with hot chocolate and a good book.	<b>depressing</b> This weather is depressing! Is it ever going to stop raining?
<b>embarrassed</b> John was really embarrassed when he fell over in front of his new boss.	<b>embarrassing</b> That is the most embarrassing photo! I look terrible!
<b>excited</b> I'm so excited! I'm going on holiday tomorrow!	<b>exciting</b> It's a really exciting book. I couldn't wait to find out what happened at the end.
<b>exhausted</b> Julie was so exhausted after her exams; she spent the next three days sleeping.	<b>exhausting</b> I hate doing housework! It's exhausting!
<b>fascinated</b> Joan was fascinated by her grandmother's stories of life in the 1920s.	<b>fascinating</b> The brain is fascinating, isn't it? It's amazing how much it can do.
<b>frightened</b> I was really frightened of bees when I was little, but I don't mind them now.	<b>frightening</b> What a frightening film! I don't want to walk home on my own now!
<b>frustrated</b> I tried all morning to send an email, but it wouldn't work. I was so frustrated!	<b>frustrating</b> It's frustrating when you want to say something in another language, but you don't know the word.
<b>interested</b> She's interested in animals, so she's thinking of studying to be a vet.	<b>interesting</b> That was a very interesting book.



<p><b>overwhelmed</b> Julie felt overwhelmed. She'd moved house, got a new job and was learning to drive, all at the same time.</p>	<p><b>overwhelming</b> I find London a bit overwhelming. It's so busy and noisy.</p>
<p><b>relaxed</b> She was so relaxed, sitting in front of the fire, that she didn't want to move.</p>	<p><b>relaxing</b> A nice hot bath is so relaxing after a long day.</p>
<p><b>satisfied</b> I'm very satisfied that I managed to order the meal in French.</p>	<p><b>satisfying</b> John loves his new job as a teacher. He says it's very satisfying when he makes a student understand.</p>
<p><b>shocked</b> I was shocked when my co-worked admitted stealing some money.</p>	<p><b>shocking</b> What a shocking crime! It's terrible.</p>
<p><b>surprised</b> She was surprised when she arrived at her class and found the other students doing an exam. She'd thought it was a normal lesson.</p>	<p><b>surprising</b> It's surprising how many people don't want to travel to another country.</p>
<p><b>terrified</b> My little son is terrified of the dark. We always leave a light on in his room at night.</p>	<p><b>terrifying</b> What a terrifying dog! It's huge!</p>
<p><b>thrilled</b> I was thrilled to win first prize in the competition.</p>	<p><b>thrilling</b> What thrilling music! It's some of the most beautiful I've ever heard.</p>
<p><b>tired</b> David's too tired to come to the cinema tonight. He's going to go to bed early.</p>	<p><b>tiring</b> My job is really tiring. I often don't get home until 10pm.</p>
